

Shopping List

❑ Backpack

Toddlers: not much larger than back
Early Childhood: fits 9x12 folder
AVOID: backpack with wheels, too large for child to walk comfortably

❑ Lunchbox

Can easily be opened by child
AVOID: fantasy and cartoon characters

❑ Reusable Containers

Fits easily in lunchbox
Snap lids that child can easily manage

❑ Water Bottle

A reusable water bottle that fits in your child's backpack.
AVOID: sippy cups

❑ Clothing

Comfortable, easy to take on and off, washable
AVOID:
Toddlers: fantasy and cartoon characters, belts, overalls, jeans, onesies, clothing with snaps
Early Childhood: fantasy and cartoon characters, belts, overalls

❑ Nap Blanket

Small thin blanket that can easily fold in a mat
AVOID: nap mats with pillows that roll up

❑ Indoor Shoes

Easy to slip on with soft/thin soles
Girls: ballet-type
Boys: thin-soled loafers
AVOID: giant fluffy cartoon slippers

❑ Outdoor Shoes

Sturdy tennis shoes with Velcro that your child can take on and off independently
AVOID: jellies, flip-flops, cowboy boots, clogs/Crocs, and tight dress shoes

❑ Rain Boots

❑ Small Laundry Bag

Can fold and fit in backpack
AVOID: plastic grocery bags

❑ Reusable Bag with a week supply of diapers

Only for children under the age of 2 who are not working on toileting independence

❑ Label all items
