After the morning work cycle, the student will take a break for lunch, outside time, and reading time. The afternoon work cycle will include individual and small group work in cultural areas, as well as virtual Enrichment classes. Teachers will hold a minimum of twice weekly virtual class meetings for community time, announcements, sharing, etc. Students are expected to complete their assignments, send to the teacher for review, and then make corrections as needed.
